PROGRAM	Activities	Outcomes	Indicators	Target
CIVIC ISSUES DEBATE GROUP	Weekly meetings of speech and debate group. Includes youth-organized service projects and culminating presentations	Improved communication skills	Ability to speak before an audience about an issue of importance	At least two-thirds of participants successfully make presentations
ROBOTICS ADVENTURE CLUB	High school students interested in science and engineering meet weekly all summer to explore robotics technologies	Youth learn component-based robot construction, engineering design concepts & programming	The robots built by students will qualify to enter a robotics challenge and demonstration at the end of the camp	80% of youth-designed machines will operate as planned
SUMMER READING PROGRAM	Daily 2-hour reading sessions with assistance and discussions (with certified instructors)	Participants develop their reading skills	Regular reading, selection of multiple genres	Most (85% or more) participants will read at least 2 different types of books over the summer
